**Staffing** staff recruited by


under the Governments

Kickstart Scheme initiative will man the Tourist Office. They will be local, trained and work in pairs. The 40 staff will rotate through the Tourist Office.





**Provisioning** (see appendix for set up costs) The premises typically 50m<sub>2</sub> will have a counter, 2 staff chairs, 4 visitor chairs, a TV and DVD, 3 tables and a rotating wire stand, staff will have 2 PC's.. The outside will be signwritten "Tourist Office" and social distancing measures and signage will be in place. Souvenirs (tasteful will be on sale) as well as local Artists work and samples of local fare.



#### Compliance

Keys and equipment will need to be signed for. A spare set of keys will be held at George Yard's offices.

#### **Key Dates**

Dependent on the granular details of the Kickstart scheme. The target is to be operational by the end of November 2020. Signwriting and provisioning will naturally need to be done before opening.



#### **Funding**

Seed Funding (ideally from Braintree District Council) will be necessary to get this off the ground.

**Funding Requirement** £7500 would cover everything required.

#### **Main Functions**

Information positively enhance the Braintree experience. Clear precise information, helpful choices.
